- 1. Complete and submit this application to tmcevent@tmc.edu by 5 PM on Wednesday, September 11, 2024.
- 2. You'll be notified via email in September 2024 if you've been selected to paint a chair.
- 3. Selected artists will receive nominations and certificates recognizing their participation and contributions. Painting tips and instructions will also be provided via email.
- 4. TMC will provide the chair and all necessary supplies for the painting.

The top 3 winners will have their chairs displayed and voted on by public guests during the October Odyssey event on **October 25, 2024**. The 1st place winner will be announced the same day and will receive a **\$1,000 check**.

THEME OF 2024

To kick off the 2024 Helix Park Adirondack Chair Art Contest, we are seeking artists who can capture the essence of Texas by highlighting the diverse elements that illuminate and inspire our state. - TMC reserves the right to determine and select all chair painters, and determine after completion whether any chair is appropriate for display as part of the project.
- · Chair designs may not contain offensive, obscene, profane, indecent or otherwise controversial content.
- Chair designs may not promote, encourage, or incite violence.
- Designs containing religious or political references, symbols, etc., will not be approved.
- Changes/additions to the structural design of the chair are not permitted. Materials other than paint cannot be applied/affixed to the chair.


